



Introductory Lighting Education



If you deal with lighting in your job, this is the course for you!

The ED-100 class is offered only once per year, and provides comprehensive instruction on state-of-the-art lighting practices. The course meets 10 times over a 5-week period, and every class is taught by a practicing professional in the lighting industry. Students will receive the course manual developed by the IESNA, as well as instructor handouts. Topics covered will include: Light and Color; Light, Vision and Perception; Light Sources; Luminaires and their Photometric Data; Lighting Calculations; Lighting Applications for Visual Performance; Lighting for Visual Impact; Exterior Lighting; Energy Management/Lighting Economics; and Daylighting. Each class will include an exam to demonstrate the student's understanding of the material, and a Certificate will be awarded upon successful completion of the course.
